

MAIDENCREEK TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION PROCUDURES

New state regulations require that customers of the Maiden creek Township Authority (MTA) be notified within 24 hours of a water emergency situation. In order to comply with the new regulations, the MTA has entered into a contract with a company called *Swift911* to provide the Township with an automated telephone notification service. This service is similar to the automated systems used by the surrounding school districts.

The system will only be activated during **emergency** situations. The Township will also have access to this system, and may use the system to provide instructions during an emergency. The Township Manager or a Member of the Board of Supervisors will be permitted to authorize the activation of the system.

The system will use an existing **public** data base to load the phone numbers into the system. Only published phone numbers will be added to the system unless you elect to register an unlisted number or cell phone number.
